









Revenue Sources (₹ crore)




State's Own Tax Revenue (₹ crore)





- SHE-Marts are **community-owned retail hubs** where women entrepreneurs can **sell their products directly**, moving beyond loan-dependent livelihoods to become **business owners**.
- The program builds on the success of the **Lakshpati Didi initiative** and supports women at **three levels - markets, capital, and networks**.
- It aims to make women self-reliant and boost the rural economy by linking women's groups to both agricultural and non-agricultural markets.

- The latest phase Mission Shakti 5.0 was launched in 2025 with expanded reach to women across the state, enhancing safety mechanisms, self-defense training, and community support.
- The campaign has led to significant drops in complaints by women and strengthened police responsiveness, helplines, and community centres.



Surya Mitras are central to UP's solar vision — they help scale clean energy adoption, strengthen energy independence, support job creation


Over 3.5 lakh rooftop systems installed, generating large-scale green power, cutting bills by 60–90% and reducing CO₂ emissions.

UP emerged as the top state in daily rooftop solar installations, leading the country under PM Surya Ghar Yojana.

Rooftop solar leadership: UP crossed 1 GW rooftop solar capacity under PM Surya Ghar, covering nearly 2.9 lakh households.

The strategy aims to enhance productivity, competitiveness, and technology adoption across sectors, along with diversifying trade and manufacturing. 

Social Outcomes



CM YUVA: Interest-free and collateral-free loans for industrial/ service projects up to ₹5 lakh, along with a 10% margin money subsidy on the project costs, in the industry/service sectors to promote entrepreneurship.

In March 2017, the state's total banking business was ₹12.80 lakh crore, which has become ₹32.79 lakh crore in December 2025.



Large scale loan distribution has been done last year, in programs like MSME Day, Chief Minister Youth Conclave, Vishwakarma Jayanti, International Trade Show and UP Diwas.

As of December 2025, total 4,30,565 banking outlets are active in the state, which include 20,913 branches, 19,191 ATMs and 4.09 lakh Bank Mitra and BC Sakhis.



57,699 financial literacy camps were organized, 22.24 lakh Jan Dhan accounts were opened, 17.14 lakh people were enrolled in Pradhan Mantri Jeevan Jyoti Bima Yojana (PMJJBY) and 43.35 lakh citizens in Pradhan Mantri Suraksha Bima Yojana (PMSBY).

Under Kisan Credit Card Scheme, limit of more than ₹1 lakh crore has been approved to 50.82 lakh farmers till December 2025.



Social Outcomes

The State has set up 'Promote Pharma,' a Section 8 not-for-profit entity with a ₹500-crore revolving fund dedicated to pharma research and innovation.



The Uttar Pradesh Pharmaceutical & Medical Device Industry Policy of 2023, offers capital subsidies (up to 25%), 50-60% interest subsidies for infrastructure/land, 100% stamp duty exemptions.



The state installed smart classrooms in 7,409 government schools and Resource Centres for Technology labs in 5,228 schools, thereby expanding modern education access

Medical colleges have grown to 83 in number today with 7,350 MBBS seats across autonomous, government, central, and private medical colleges.




For 2024-25, NABARD projected a substantial credit inflow of ₹5.73 lakh crore into Uttar Pradesh's priority sectors. UP leads the country with a CD ratio of 60.39 as of December, 2025

AI-ML curriculum has been introduced in 150 government ITIs, and 11 new trades are being included under the new education policy. Additionally, 5 CIIT centres are being set up in the state, where new technologies will be taught.
